Answers: (1) Glass trumpet, violoncello, horn in F; (2) hammering patterns, shaving off metal, buffing, laser etching; (3) paper Rolls section—Apollonia, QR5, etc.; (4) frame drums, big drums, small drums, made with wood, plastic, fiberglass, etc.; (5) gong-making workshop, sanza workshop, Belize; (6) costumes and props used during celebrations or festivals, tools that are used in making musical instruments, etc.; and (7) drums come in many different shapes and sizes, some have membranes stretched over them, some don't, they can be played with hands or beaters, many are hollowed out, etc.
